

Students pursuing an undergraduate degree in History should use this worksheet to plan their course of study.

HST 300: Historical Imagination HST 300 4 cred

This course is required of all majors, and is a prerequisite for all seminar courses (see below).

HST 407: Seminar HST 407 4 cred

Two seminar courses, of any historical field, are required of all majors. HST 407 4 cred

HST 495: Comparative World History HST 495 4 cred

This course is required of all majors.

Remaining coursework may be satisfied by electives in History, subject to the following distribution requirements:

Students may count a maximum of 12 credits of lower-division (100- or 200-level) history courses towards the major.
