

**Anne P. Myers History Scholarships**

Anne Myers, a 1994 graduate of Portland State University, has served the university and the Department of History as one of the founding members of the Friends of History and as a current member of the PSU Foundation Board. As an undergraduate major in History, Anne took many history classes and would now like to help other worthy History majors who find themselves in difficult financial circumstances to accomplish their educational goals.

Three scholarships of up to \$300 will be awarded annually to History majors to help defray the cost of books and classroom materials.

**Application Guidelines**

1. Applicants should have a 3.0 overall GPA with a minimum 3.25 GPA in History, and must be declared undergraduate History majors.
2. Applicants will be judged based on academic performance, service to the university/community, and need for financial assistance.
3. A brief (300 words or less) statement of circumstances should accompany this application. Please attach your essay to this sheet. Questions that should be addressed in this essay are:

Why you should receive this award: i.e., your academic performance, service to PSU and the community  
Your goals, and how a degree in History will help you accomplish them  
Special circumstances affecting your education (family obligations, finances, employment status, etc.)

Applicants' essays will be reviewed by officers of Phi Alpha Theta selected by the Department of History.

Applications are due in the PSU Department of History (Cramer 441) **on Friday, February 27, 2009 by 5:00 P.M.** The department will notify all students regarding the status of their application for this scholarship before the end of March.
